MERRILY WE ROLL ALONG

It's the best thing that ever could have happened! Following sold-out runs in London and at the New York Theatre Workshop, *Merrily We Roll Along* is returning to Broadway — and with Maria Friedman's widely acclaimed production, it is poised at last to take its place in the pantheon of great American musicals. Featuring one of Sondheim's most celebrated and personal scores, and moving backwards in time, *Merrily* charts the turbulent relationship between three lifelong friends — composer Franklin Shepard (Grammy Award winner Jonathan Groff), writer Mary Flynn (Tony and Grammy Award nominee Lindsay Mendez) and lyricist & playwright Charley Kringas (Grammy Award nominee Daniel Radcliffe) — and traces every milestone of their lives for nearly two decades as they navigate success, show business and unbreakable bonds.

HERE LIES LOVE

Here Lies Love is a groundbreaking American musical about the Filipino people from the brilliant minds of David Byrne (Academy Award®, Grammy Award®, and Tony Award® winner) and Fatboy Slim (Grammy Award® winner) which Time Out New York calls “an ecstatic and dynamic party.”

With choreography by Annie-B Parson (Olivier Award nominee) and directed by Alex Timbers (Tony Award® winner), the theater is transformed into a dance club where the audience is immersed in the journey of former Filipina First Lady Imelda Marcos and the Philippine People Power Revolution.

BACK TO THE FUTURE : THE MUSICAL

Welcome to Hill Valley! When Marty McFly finds himself transported back to 1955 in a time machine built by the eccentric scientist Doc Brown, he accidentally changes the course of history. Now he's in a race against time to fix the present, escape the past and send himself... back to the future.

Back to the Future: The Musical won the Olivier Award for Best New Musical, four WhatsOnStage Awards, including Best New Musical, and the Broadway World Award for Best New Musical. The productions in London and Manchester have so far been seen by half a million people and the musical has broken box office records at the Adelphi Theatre.

THE COTTAGE

The Cottage is a hilarious new farce by Sandy Rustin. Set in the English countryside in 1923, this tale of sex, betrayal and love unfolds when Sylvia decides to expose her affair to both her husband and to her lover's wife. The true meaning of fate, identity and marriage are called into question as a surprising and hilarious web of secrets unravels in this ridiculous – potentially murderous – romantic comedy.

THE SHARK IS BROKEN

The Shark is Broken is a moving and brilliantly hilarious behind-the-scenes drama, and celebration of movie history.

FADE IN: The open ocean, 1974. Production on *Jaws* is delayed...again. The film's lead actors—theatre veteran Robert Shaw and young Hollywood hotshots, Richard Dreyfuss and Roy Scheider—are crammed into a too-small boat, entirely at the mercy of foul weather and a faulty mechanical co-star. Alcohol flows, egos collide, and tempers flare on a chaotic voyage that just might lead to cinematic magic...if it doesn't sink them all.

ROCK & ROLL MAN, THE MUSICAL

Rock & Roll Man is the original musical about a musical original.

Alan Freed was a Cleveland DJ who heard the future—and knew he had to let it sing. He named the genre “Rock & Roll,” bringing music to the masses and integrating artists and audiences on the airwaves and in concerts for the first time in history. Along the way, he became an icon to the nation's youth—and a target for the nation's establishment.

Rock & Roll Man features classics created by legends such as Little Richard, Chuck Berry, LaVern Baker, Buddy Holly, Bo Diddley, Jerry Lee Lewis, and Screamin' Jay Hawkins, as well as original songs written just for the stage.
